## Cutting Instructions:

- 1) Cut the fabric for the ends of the borders into 4 --  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  squares (These should be the same fabric.)
- 2) Cut 12 --  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles.
- 3) Cut 32 --  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares.

## Sewing Instructions:

- 1) Take all of your  $1\frac{1}{2}''$  squares. Randomly sew four of them together as shown. Make 8 of Unit A.



Unit A: Make 8

- 2) Take your  $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$  rectangles and sew them into pairs as shown. Make 6 of Unit B.



Unit B: Make 6

- 3) Layout border with the  $4\frac{1}{2}''$  squares at either end and then alternating Unit A and Unit B as shown.



Make 2

- 4) Sew onto the top and bottom of your quilt.
