

Round Robin Row Quilt

Row #2 by Patchwork Posse



Chunky Flowers

Materials Needed:

7—7 inch X 7 Inch squares {flower}

14—2 ½" X 2 ½" squares {background}

7—2 ½ " X 2 ½" squares for center of flowers

Step 1:

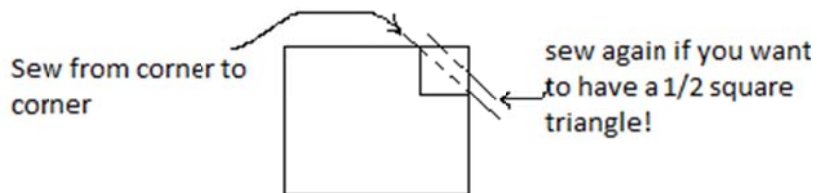
Take a flower {7X7 block} and place a 2 ½" X 2 ½" square in one corner. Right sides together.

Step 2:

Sew from corner to corner or the smaller square. Hint~ if you need to mark with pencil this line to follow when sewing do it!

Step 3:

Pivot at the end and sew ½" from the sewn line. This will give you a tiny ½ square triangle for later use. You can totally skip this step if you don't have triangle-it is. ☺ these could also be used as spacers at the end when sewing all the rows together.



Step 4:

Repeat the first 3 steps with all 4 corners of EACH flower.

Step 5:

Lay a few of the center squares in a pile and cut them into a circle.

Step 6:

Pin 1 circle in the center of each flower block. Sew around ¼" away from the outside edge. This edge will rag later and be totally cute.

Step 7:

Sew the flower blocks in a row together.
