# Chenille Christmas Stocking

Use up those cutter quilts or vintage chenille fabric, add a bit of embroidered hankies for the perfect combination.

## Materials List:

Chenille- ½ yard

Cotton Fabric for lining: ½ yard

Hankies, lace, doilies or embroidered table runners for the heel, toe and top edge parts.

## OUTSIDE~

**Step 1:** Cut out templates

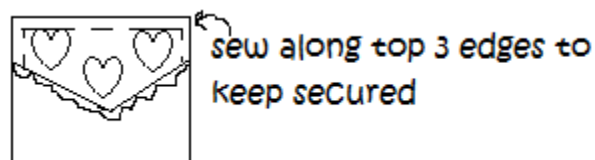
**Step 2:** Lay templates on chenille fabric and cut out 2. These will be for the outside of the stocking.

**Step 3:** Cut out an additional 2 out of the lining material.

**Step 4:** Cut out the template for the hankie piece at the top of the stocking.

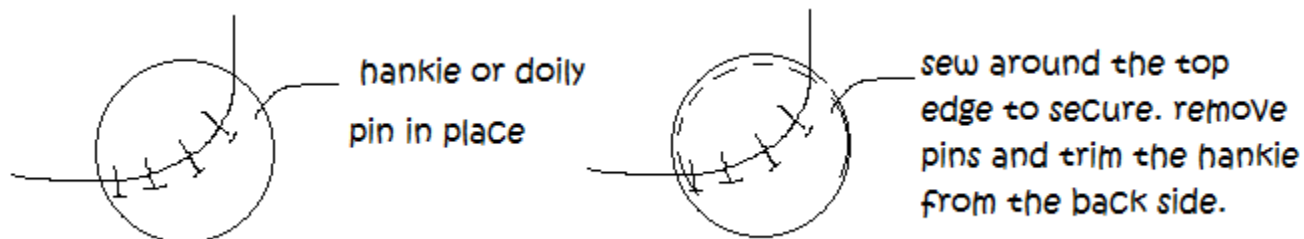
**Step 5:** Lay template on hankie and move it around until you find the perfect placing—you can center any embroidery work in the point area.

**Step 6:** Place the hankie piece on the top of the front chenille stocking. Sew around the three edges so it is secure. Keep the seam stitching under ¼” so it won’t show with the final stitching.



**Step 7:** Place the other hankie at either the ankle area or toe area. Move it around to make the best use of the embroidery. Pin in place.

Sew around the top edge to secure. Remove the pins and flip over. Trim the hankie from the backside, following the outline of the stocking shape.



**Step 8:** Lay right sides together- the front and back of the stocking. Pin together.

**Step 9:** Sew all the way around the stocking. Turn right sides out.

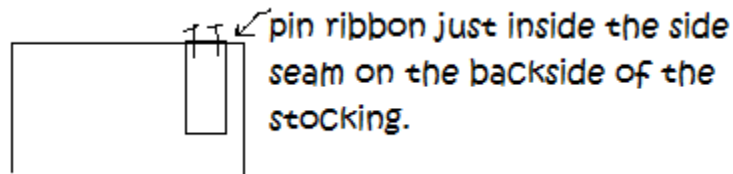
## LINING~

**Step 10:** Lay right sides together—the lining pieces. Pin together.

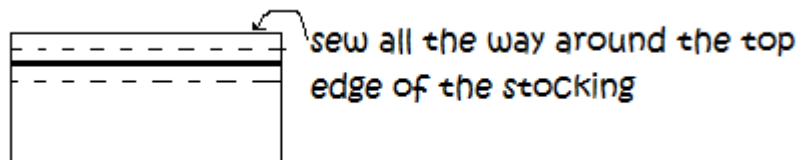
**Step 11:** Sew all the way around the stocking lining—LEAVING 3” on the bottom of the foot area to turn.

**Step 12:** Place your hand into the outside stocking piece and stuff inside the lining stocking.

**Step 13:** Pin the ribbon loop just behind the side seam.



**Step 14:** Sew all the way around the top edge.

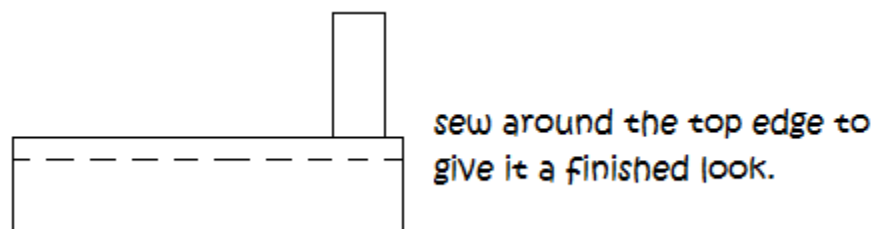


**Step 15:** Pull the stocking through the lining hole. Sew the turning hole closed.

**Step 16:** Stuff the lining inside the stocking.

**Step 17:** Iron the top edge flat.

**Step 18:** Sew all the way around the top edge 1/4"

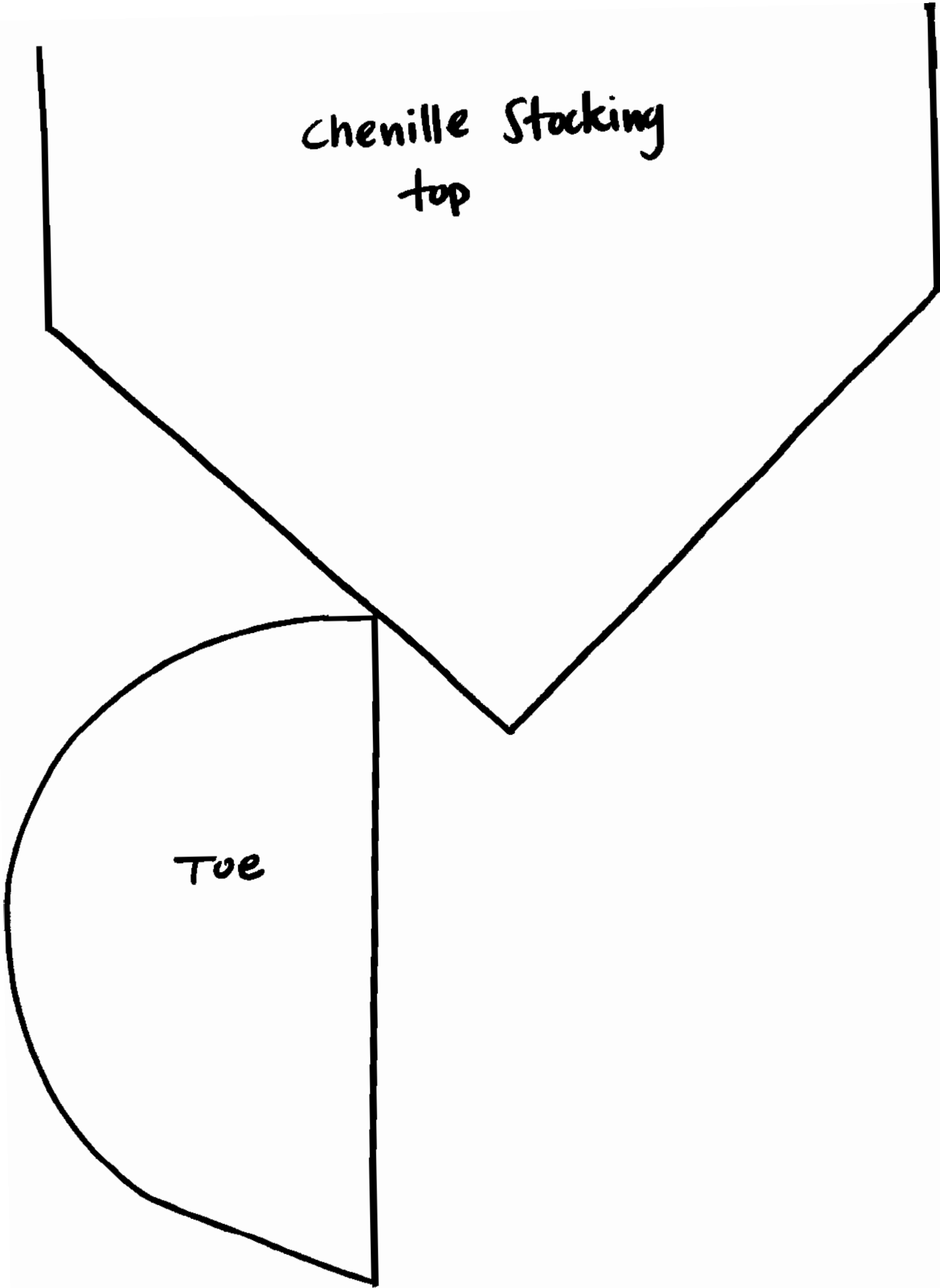
