

# MidNight Frost



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## General Instructions

1. Please read through all directions before beginning.
2. All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise stated.
3. WOF = width of fabric

## Fabric Requirements:

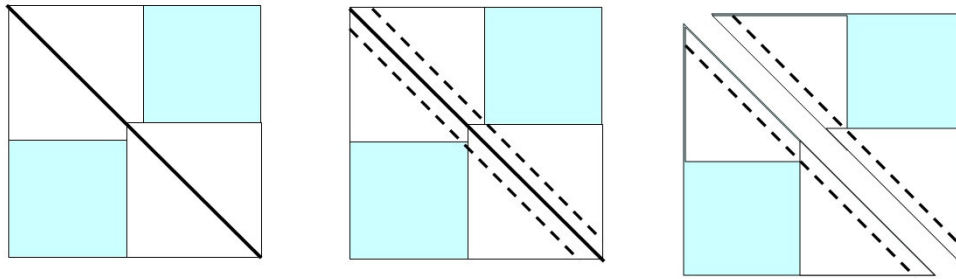
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of focal fabric A
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of focal fabric B
- $\frac{1}{4}$  yard of background fabric

## Cutting Instructions

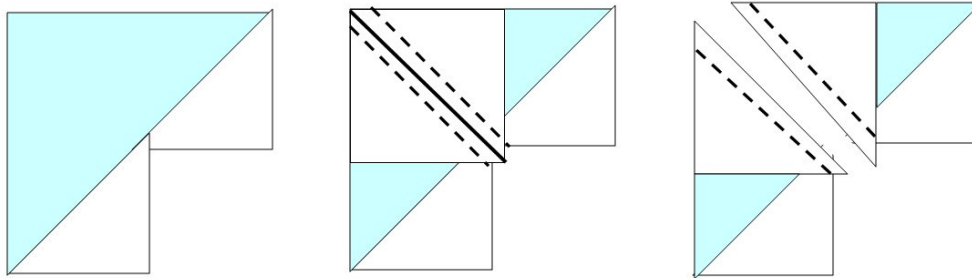
1. From each of the 2 focal fabrics cut:
  - a. (3)  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square
  - b. (18) 3" x 3" squares
2. From the background fabric cut:
  - a. (24)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " square
  - b. (12) 3" x 3" squares

## Sewing Units – Flying Geese

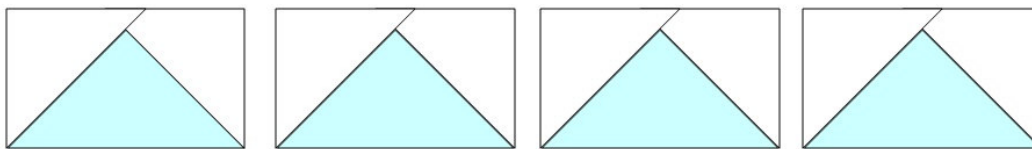
1. Place (2)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " background squares on a focal fabric  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square with right sides together as shown.
2. Draw a line diagonally from the top left corner to the bottom right corner
3. Stitch on either side of the drawn line
4. Cut along drawn line separating 2 sewn pieces.



5. Press seams toward background fabric.
6. Place (1)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " background square onto each of the 2 pieced units with right sides together as shown.
7. Draw a line diagonally from the top left corner to the bottom right corner
8. Stitch on either side of the drawn line on each of the 2 pieced units
9. Cut along the drawn line on each of the 2 pieced units to create 4 units.



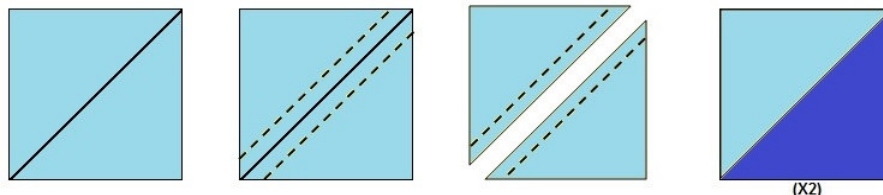
10. Press seams towards background fabric.
11. Trim tails from sides and top of each of the 4 units



12. Repeat to make a total of 24 flying geese units in the following fabric layouts  
 12 focal fabric A flying geese      12 focal fabric B flying geese

## Sewing Units – Half Square Triangles

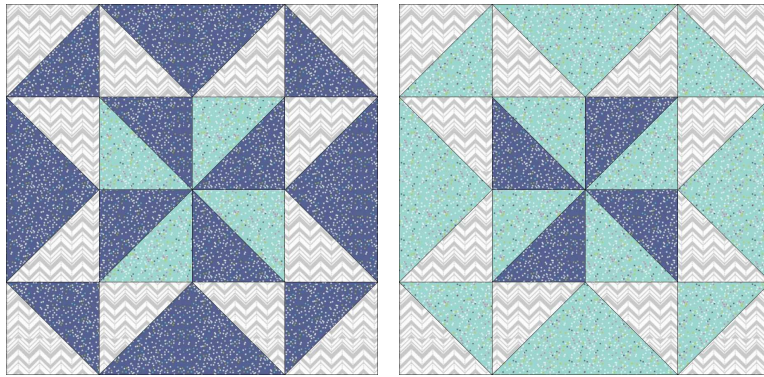
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the lighter focal fabric  $3$ " x  $3$ " square.
2. Place the marked square on the darker focal fabric  $3$ " x  $3$ " square with right sides together.
3. Stitch on either side of the marked line. Cut along the marked line. Press 2 pieces open.
4. Using the diagonal seam, trim block to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



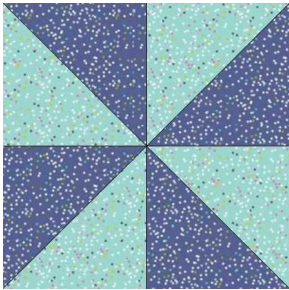
5. Repeat to make a total of 48 Half Square Triangle units in the following fabric layouts  
 24 Focal A/Focal B HST's,      12 Focal A/Background HST's,      12 Focal B/Background HST's.

## Sewing Blocks

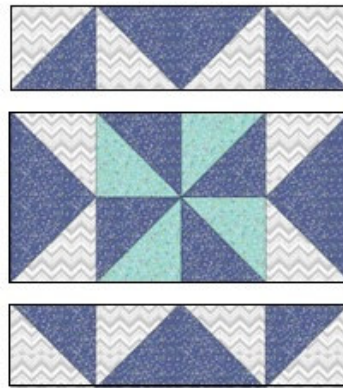
1. Layout block as follows, in either color layout.



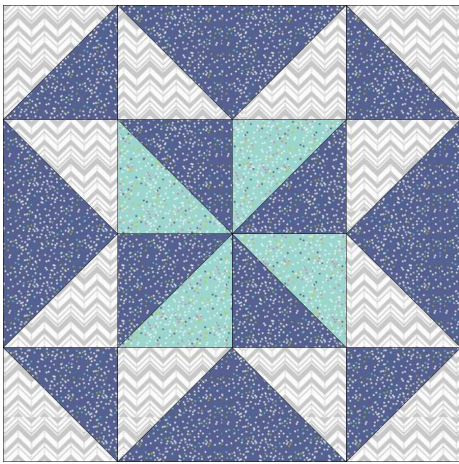
2. Stitch 4 center HST's into center square.



3. Sew pieced units into rows.



4. Sew rows into blocks.



5. Repeat to make a total of 6 blocks, 3 of each color layout.

6. Sew blocks into row.
